Introduction to the project:	The aim of this project is to acquire new knowledge through the inclusion of young scouts through organizing different seminars, competitions and programs with the theme of preserving the environment, healthy lifestyles and development of skills, and forming educational and non-institutional programs for young scouts in Montenegro. It is with emphasis on the learning and sustainability of the action plan for youth in Montenegro. In the envisaged program, we emphasized several concrete activities that bear the following goals: Youth activities in society, education in the field of science, research, technology, sustainability, health, environmental protection, research on the situation of youth in Montenegro, creating programs for young scouts. This program includes seminar, competition for over 100 scouts, research about youth in Montenegro, implementing the school in nature, visit to two National Parks and training for youth about first aid in cooperation with the Red Cross of Montenegro.
Objectives and goals:	Education of young scouts through the camps and competitions in National Parks. Improvement of already acquired skills. Strengthening of Scout movement at northern region of Montenegro. Strengthening of local scout group through this project. Inclusion of young people from minority communities in Montenegro.
To which extent did we meet objectives and goals:	Through different activities that we implemented, we absolutely met objectives and goals gaining new skills, knowledge and strengthening scout movement in northern region of Montenegro.



What did we learn from the project:	We learned about position of scouts and youth in Montenegro and how to improve it. We acquired new knowledge and skills in scouting through competition (geography, flora and fauna of Montenegro, orientation). Also we learned about sustainability and environmental protection. We gained and fulfilled our knowledge about first aid through training for youth.
