A: The story

Project name:	This is our world – Let's grow
Responsible organization and person(s):	Association of Scouts of Montenegro Scouts Unit – "Skitač" – Nikšić Nikola Spaić
Introduction to the project:	<p>The project "This is our world – Let's grow" was able to above all fulfill its main goal. A new unit has been formed in Nikšić, which, after half a year, has over 40 new members. This unit organized for the short period of its existence three activities that brought together Montenegrin Scouts also Scouts from Belgium and Israel.</p> <p>With this project, we got a new unit that also promoted Scouting in the town of Nikšić and, as part of those promotions, introduced over 300 young people to the Scouting mission. In order to make this project a success, four leaders of the new unit mentioned above were included in Training for young leaders of Association of Scouts of Montenegro, in which we trained young leaders to how to manage an unit in a quality way.</p> <p>As part of this project, Scout Unit "Skitač" managed to provide new equipment, new tents, coasters, sleeping bags, sound system, electronic equipment and other things for easier work.</p> <p>In the end, as a crowning success of this great project, more than 40 Scouts of the Scout Unit "Skitač" participated in a seven-day camp organized in Kotor and Žabljak. All participants had the opportunity to get acquainted with Scouting in Montenegro in a high quality way and to try climbing, rafting, signaling, topography and other Scouting disciplines.</p>
Objectives and goals:	<p>The main goal of the project "This is our world- Let's grow" is forming of a new scout unit in Nikšić so that more kids could be included in the scout program.</p> <p>The indirect goal is to grow the membership at the national level, to affect the education of young people through different workshops, creation of new leaders and promotion of healthy styles of life.</p>



To which extent did we meet objectives and goals:	All the goals of this project have been successfully realized, the creation of a new, quality Unit is reflected in regular meetings and activities carried out according to plan. At national level the organization has received a reliable partner and the city of Nikšić has got another social active youth organization.
What did we learn from the project:	This project has helped us to better understand the administration in the formation of new Units, it has also enabled us to see what young people want, primarily how they want to spend their free time. The project helped to establish contacts with various organizations and offered the opportunity to cooperate internationally as well.
