



## ESF report

### A: The story

Project name:	First aid skills for every child
Responsible organization and person(s):	The Polish Scouting and Guiding Association, Aleksandra Karwala
Introduction to the project:	First aid skills are absolutely key skills for every responsible citizen. Scouts should have that skills. They should be leaders in first aid. Unfortunately, without necessary equipment there is no possibility to prepare a course for them. Children come from excluded rural areas. There is no money for courses like this. Team leaders will prepare series of trainings in their teams. Subsequently scouts will conduct trainings and demonstrations for local society. They will also prepare action to promote first aid in the village where they live. It will be also an opportunity to promote scouting. To raise the quality of first aid education 3 leaders will participate in Qualified First Aid Course – this is required by Polish law for everyone, who works with kids (under 18). They will get national certificate which is necessary to be a leader on a summer camp. During the courses scouts will gain scout badges connected with first aid. Local nurses, doctors and firefighters will help team leaders in this educational process as a volunteers.
Objectives and goals:	<p>The overall objective of this project is broadening first aid skills.</p> <p>We wanted to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Organize first aid courses on a scout meetings,</li> <li>• Give an opportunity to take part in qualified first aid course for 3 leaders,</li> <li>• Promote first aid skills in local society,</li> <li>• Encourage children to gain first aid scout badges.</li> </ul>
To which extent did we meet objectives and goals:	<p>We do our bests to meet objectives and goals despite the COVID-19 pandemic.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. We've prepared 15 scout leaders to teach children first aid during first aid course. We've decided for a regular not a qualified course, because we can teach more leaders on one course.</li> <li>2. This project helped us in acquiring first aid equipment for our scout teams.</li> </ol>



	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>3. Our team leaders can teach first aid on a professional mannequins with professional AED.</li><li>4. We've promoted first aid in our teams. A dozen scouts gained first aid scout badges.</li><li>5. We established long term cooperation with local doctors and nurses, who are a parents of our scouts. We will invite them on a scout meetings as soon as it will be possible despite the COVID-19 pandemic.</li></ol> <p>We've given a knowledge about first aid and prepared team leaders for showing children first aid in real as the pandemic restrictions will give us that possibility. We hope that we can do that summer camp in 2021. We are planning to promote first aid skills in local society during to the harvest festival in autumn.</p>
What did we learn from the project:	<p>Due to the COVID-19 pandemic we were obliged to do most of activities on-line. We've organized theoretical part of first aid course on-line. We learned how to communicate efficiently in team leaders' group during this project. We are prepared to teach children first aid. We realized how important are first aid skills for everyone. We've also learned how to organize first aid course in pandemic time according to all regulations. Our project isn't finished it just had started.
