Project title: "Journey to Myself"

Project objectives: Through "Journey to Myself" we aim to meet the needs of the scouts at the age and stage of personal development where they are defining their personality and asking themselves questions about their profession. The activities' programme is structured in three camps and offers them the possibility to evaluate themselves on three areas: physically and mentally, social and scientific. Each area has as its objective defining the child as a person depending on the answers to the 3 defining questions: Who am I and where am I? What do I like and what do I not? Where do I want to be and where do I get there? Each camp will be designed on each answer to a question and from each area.

After participating at the 3 camps, the children will have an idea regarding the compatibility they have with certain domains and the way they could end up working in the desired domain. Additionally, because of the effects of the pandemic and the necessity of the local centre to follow a new path, a path open to as many as possible, we will try to analyze our current situation, where we want to be and how we could achieve this. It will be an objective analysis, based on facts and concrete achievements and with the participation of all scouts aged 16 and more.
